

Automated Trash Collection

- **Place** cart so handle faces your home.
- **If Possible** put trash in disposable bags to prevent trash from blowing.
- **Avoid** placing cart under low hanging branches, wires or trees.
- **If at all possible place** cart 3 feet away from permanent structures (mailbox, poles, etc). & separate carts from each other by at least 2 1/2 ft.
- **If at all possible keep** cart away from parked vehicles & place on level surface.
- **Keep** cart away from yard waste bags and bundles.
- **No** recyclables in trash cart.
- **Close** the lid on the cart to prevent scattering of debris by wind or animals.
- **Wheels** should be against the curb if cart is placed in the street.
- **Container** should be placed curbside no sooner than 12 hrs. prior to collection and removed no later than 12 hrs. after collection.

Please place your 96 gallon green trash cart and 35 gallon blue commingle cart curbside on your next regular trash collection day.

Place your gray 65 gallon paper recycling cart curbside on the next regular Monday collection day.

You may use your red and green recycling bins for storage. In the event they are in poor condition, place them curbside for trash collection with a note indicating they are to be picked up.

WHAT GOES IN THE MIX?

Aluminum Cans

Steel Cans

Tin Cans

Glass

#1 Plastic

#2 Plastic

All of the above material will be put in the blue thirty-five gallon recycling cart and placed curbside by 7 AM on your regular trash collection day.



Aluminum

- Beverage Cans

Rinse thoroughly and crush to conserve space in your recycling bin.

Steel and Tin

- Steel Cans
- Tin Cans
- Lids

Please rinse the can, put the lid in the can and then carefully squeeze close the top of the can.

Glass

- All Color Jars & Bottles
- Rinse the container thoroughly.

Plastic

- All Plastic Containers Clear or Colored with a #1 or #2 on the bottom.

Empty contents, rinse lightly, remove lid, crush container. If the lid is not a #1 or #2 plastic, put it in the trash.

A plastic container without a number is not acceptable.

If the container is recyclable you will find a triangular-shaped symbol composed of three arrows, with either a "1" or a "2" in the center.

Newspaper/Junk Mail Recycling

- Newspaper/inserts
- All Books - Hardback books with covers
- Magazines, catalogs, phone books
- Office paper, brown paper bags
- Junk mail - advertisements
- Paperboard - cereal, shoe, cracker boxes, etc., remove plastic liners and throw liners in regular trash
- Corrugated cardboard - please flatten
- Six or twelve pack soda carton carriers
- Gift Wrap
- Manila file folders
- Paper plates & towels
- All Paper Products

All of the above paper products will be put in the gray 65 gallon paper recycling cart and placed curbside by 7 AM on Mondays.
