Examples of What to Bring:

Obsolete Tax Documents, Bank Statements/Cancelled Checks, Sensitive information, birthdates, social security information, signatures, passwords and pins, Credit Card Statements and Receipts, Credit Card Offers, Reports and Histories, business records.

Do not to bring: newspapers, books or magazines, plastic covering or cardboard, CD’s or floppy discs.

You can use any container from plastic bags to boxes, etc. Whatever type container is easiest to transport from your home to your vehicle to get the items to the event. There will be a drive through so you do not have to exit your vehicle.
